In rhetoric, linguistics and poetry, onomatopoeia is a figure of speech that employs a word, or occasionally, a grouping of words, that imitates the sound it is describing, and thus suggests its source object, such as â€œbangâ€• or â€œclickâ€•, or animal such as â€œmooâ€•, â€œoinkâ€•, â€œquackâ€•, or â€œmeowâ€•.
