= Wild flowers of different kinds "are going to grow/will be growing/would be growing/(will grow)" all over the hills and around the lake.

= There will be wild flowers of different kinds growing all over the hills and around the lake. (Envisioning only.)

Grown all over the hills and around the lake are wild flowers of different kinds.

= Wild flowers of different kinds are (being) grown all over the hills and around the lake.

= Having seen growing all over the hills and around the lake are wild flowers of different kinds.

= Wild flowers of different kinds are being seen growing all over the hills and around the lake.
